DISCUSSION GUIDE

- **2.** If you're willing, share the story of your spiritual rebirth. How did you come to the realization that you needed Jesus, not just "religion"? John 3:5-8
- **3.** Who in your life needs to know the truth of <u>John 3:9-15</u>? Read the passage, then stop and jot down the name(s) God brings to your mind and ask Him for opportunities to have those conversations.
- **4.** How do you know for sure that your story matters to God despite anything in your past, present or future? Read <u>John 3:16-17</u>. Share your response with the group.

What did <u>Jesus</u> have to say to ordinary people like you and me?

1. Why Do We Need a New Birth?

Jesus gave a spiritual *biology lesson* to a very significant and distinguished individual (note <u>John 3:1</u>).

Jesus referred to him as Israel's teacher...THE Teacher of Israel.

Note John 3:2.3

What was Nicodemus hoping to <u>hear?</u>

The key is knowing where to get the latest word from God and from Whom.

Nicodemus discovered (and we can, too) that Jesus is the right <u>destination</u> in our search for truth and for God.

Instead of congratulating him for his religious performance, Jesus told him that his religious pursuits were <u>futile</u>.

Note John 3:4

Note John 3:5-8

Born of *water* = purified, cleansing, repentance.

Born of *Spirit* = rebirth, regeneration.

Note Isaiah 64:6b

We don't need a self-improvement program, a self-help <u>scheme</u>, or a set of rules/rituals.

We need the spiritual transformation Jesus offers as a <u>aift</u>.

2. How Can We Experience the New Birth?

Note John 3:9-15

Nicodemus had to understand that his religious background, training, and practices didn't make him a <u>spiritual</u> person.

Note Numbers 21 (especially vs. 8).

Your story really does matter to Jesus:

- ...can transform our lives.
- ...gives the gift of eternal life.
- ...can give us a new birth and a new <u>start</u>.
- Note John 3:16
