DISCUSSION GUIDE

Icebreaker: It's a rainy spring day and you have the day to just be at home; what will you be doing?

- 1. We often think of others as being worse off than we are, and spiritual condition is no exception. Take some time to read through the terms and passages laid out in the message notes that reveal our universal condition without Jesus.
- **2.** What response does this list cause in you? Can you relate, do you remember what it felt like, are you still there?
- **3.** The local people had seen what Jesus had accomplished in the demoniac's life, yet they still resisted him. (<u>Luke 8:30-37</u>) How did this look, or does this currently look, in your own relationship with Jesus?
- **4.** While you may not have been in the same situation as this man, how did you feel when Jesus transformed* you? (*Colossians 1:13-14, 2 Corinthians 5:17)
- **5.** "Jesus transforms us to use us." The demoniac was sent to tell those he already knew what Jesus had done for him. How will you accomplish Jesus' purpose of reaching those in your life who don't know Him yet this Easter? (Ephesians 2:10, Luke 8:38-39)

MESSAGE NOTES

What did Jesus have to say to ordinary people like <u>us</u>? What did He do in people's lives?

It's no coincidence that right after Jesus calmed the storm (something that was humanly <u>untamable</u>, note <u>Luke 8:22-25</u>) that Jesus stepped ashore and was confronted with a human being that also seemed <u>untamable</u> (note <u>Luke 8:27-29</u>).

1. Human Beings are in a <u>Desperate</u> Spiritual State

- A. The Gadarene demoniac—although our external condition may not ever <u>resemble</u> anything close to this...our spiritual state <u>apart</u> from Jesus has many similarities to this man.
 - <u>Lost</u> (<u>Luke 19:10</u>)
 - Alienated from God (Colossians 1:21)
 - Condemned (Romans 5:18)
 - Darkness (Ephesians 5:8)
 - <u>Dead</u> in transgressions (<u>Ephesians 2:5</u>)
 - Separate from Christ...excluded from citizenship in Israel...foreigners to the covenants of the promise...without hope...without <u>God</u>... (<u>Ephesians 2:12</u>)
 - Darkened in...understanding...separated from the <u>life</u> of God... hardened hearts...ignorant...lost all sensitivity... (<u>Ephesians 4:18-19</u>)
 - In the <u>dominion</u> of darkness (<u>Colossians 1:13</u>)
 - Dead in your sins (<u>Colossians 2:13</u>)
 - Sinners...God's <u>enemies</u> (<u>Romans 5:8, 10</u>)

All of these terms (and others) paint a picture of spiritual desperation for any person <u>apart</u> from Jesus.

B. The <u>people</u> of this area (note <u>Luke 8:30-37</u>) - Human beings apart from a <u>personal</u> relationship with Jesus are in a desperate spiritual state...and yet can still reject the One who can meet their deepest needs and make life <u>worth living</u>.

2. Jesus Dramatically <u>Transforms</u> People

Note Luke 8:27-29, 35b

The <u>conversion</u> of any human being is the greatest miracle God performs (note Colossians 1:13-14: 2 Corinthians 5:17).

3. Jesus Transforms Us to Use Us

Note Luke 8:38

Jesus sent him away not as a punishment, but for a purpose (note Luke 8:39a).

Note Luke 8:39b

You know what I was. You see what I am. Jesus made the difference.

Jesus changed our lives, makes us part of His Body, gives us spiritual gifts, and equips us to serve and minister in His Name (note <u>Philippians 1:4-6;</u> <u>Ephesians 2:10</u>).
