- Observe... Jesus is kicking at "Glamour Shots" religion.
 - o Our awareness is limited.
 - But Jesus will teach us.
 - o Our sacrifice is <u>daily</u>.
 - But Jesus inspires us <u>by example</u>.
 - o Our agreement is <u>not enough</u>.
 - But Jesus keeps appealing.
 - o Our orientation is backward.
 - But Jesus invites us forward.

When in doubt, Hebrews 12:1-3 clarifies to "follow along."

Where Are They Now? (Luke 8:4-15, The Message)*

- The Road (aka A World of Hurt)
 - o It's the difference between exposure and concentration.
 - o Try this: Be "pro-Life" in everything. (Philippians 4:8-9)
- The Rocks (aka Gravelly Voices)
 - o It's the difference between surviving and thriving.
 - o Try this: Be <u>hydrated</u> by Jesus. (<u>John 7:37-39</u>)
- The Weeds (aka <u>Look-A-Likes</u>)
 - o It's the difference between accommodation and accountability.
 - o Try this: Be <u>patient</u> in your labeling. (<u>Matthew 13:24-30</u>)
- The Soil (aka Being Planted)
 - o It's the difference between mentorship and <u>discipleship</u>.
 - o Try this: Be encouraged by the multiplication. (Exodus 20:6)

*Note: In all four options, the seeds were always good.
