## **DISCUSSION GUIDE**

*Icebreaker:* If you could live in any decade (previous or future), what decade would you pick and why?

- **1.** Many of us have hoped for the surprise letter indicating we've inherited a substantial gift from a distant relative we don't know well or even know was in our family tree. As a Christ-follower, how does <u>1 Peter 1:3-9</u> describe our inheritance?
- **2.** While Jesus shields us (<u>1 Peter 1:5</u>), Pastors Nate and Tony indicated that it can sometimes feel confining or restrictive and we can mistakenly think we're missing out/held back from something. How might we understand Jesus' safekeeping as a wonderful gift?
- **3.** "Jesus keeps after us," motivated by love and wanting new life for each of us. How have you experienced Jesus' safekeeping as He described in John 10:10-15?
- **4.** In your Message Notes, both Pastors Tony and Nate listed the "payoff" of Jesus' pursuit and safekeeping. Review what we are kept from and released to. Which of these is most encouraging to you?
- **5.** As we find our *REAL ID* in Christ, we were challenged to choose God's truth over our feelings and to give up dangerous things in order to claim lifegiving things. Read <u>Philippians 1:6</u> and <u>Jude 24-25</u>. How will you let Jesus keep after you considering these promises?

- ...we are kept from <u>anxiety winning</u> and released to <u>breakthroughs</u>.
- ...we are kept from sin and death and released to new life!
