- **4.** What things are different in your life due to being in Christ's death, burial and resurrection? (<u>Galatians 5:16-26</u>) Or alternatively, what would your life look like if you weren't a Jesus follower, according to this passage?
- **5.** Have you said your own YES! to Jesus? What's stopping you from finding your REAL ID in Jesus? (2 Corinthians 6:1-2) If you're already a Jesus follower, what step do you need to take to find more of your identity in Him? (John 15:4-5)

MESSAGE NOTES

When we don't know who we are, or if we have <u>wrong</u> ideas about who we are...it will impact everything about our life...

The more we realize that "we're in…in Christ", it will shape our understanding of our REAL ID in profound and very <u>practical</u> ways.

1. The <u>Biq</u> Picture

What it means to be in Christ is a dominant theme in the New Testament.

The Apostle Paul used this expression the most (about <u>200</u> times).

The Apostle John also uses this expression... (note John 15:4a, 5; 17:20-23).

- "created in Christ" (note Ephesians 2:10)
- "seated with Christ in heavenly places" (note <u>Ephesians 2:6</u>)
- He "<u>dwells</u> in our hearts" (<u>Ephesians 3:17</u>)
- Christ is "in us" (note <u>2 Corinthians 13:5</u>) and we're "in Him" (note <u>1 Corinthians 1:30</u>).
- In Christ we're <u>justified</u> (note <u>Romans 8:1</u>)...
- ...glorified (note Romans 8:30)...
- ...sanctified (note <u>1 Corinthians 1:2</u>)...
- ...<u>called</u> (note <u>1 Corinthians 1:9</u>)...
- ...made alive (note Ephesians 2:5)...
- ...created <u>anew</u> (note <u>2 Corinthians 5:17</u>)...
- ...adopted (note <u>Galatians 3:26</u>)
- And He "chose us" (note Ephesians 1:4).

2. At the <u>Heart</u> of it All

The clearest and most concise definition of the gospel is 1 Corinthians 15:1-8...

Note Galatians 2:20; Colossians 2:12; Romans 6:3-5

- A. I am in Christ's crucifixion/death—not only did Jesus die <u>for</u> us; He also died <u>instead</u> of us. And when He died for us and instead of us, He also placed us "in Him", so we were crucified with Him. Note <u>Matthew</u> 27:37 and Colossians 2:14-15.
- B. I am in Christ's <u>burial</u> (note <u>Colossians 2:12a</u>) our <u>past</u> has been buried with Jesus (note <u>Psalm 103:10-12</u>; <u>Isaiah 1:18</u>; <u>38:17</u>; <u>43:25</u>; <u>1 John 1:9</u>).
- C. I am <u>raised</u> with Christ (note <u>Colossians 2:12-13</u>) We have been raised with Jesus so we now have the option and <u>ability</u> to live a new life (note <u>Romans 6:4-7, 11</u>). Our old nature has one <u>default</u> setting...but if we are *in Christ* we are given a <u>new</u> nature (note <u>Galatians 5:16-17, 24-25</u>)...
