Icebreaker: Three things in my life that I'm most thankful for right now would be...

- **1.** Pastor Tom began his message talking about how important our spiritual bloodlines are in helping us form our **REAL ID**. What are some of the highlights of your natural bloodline, AKA your family?

MESSAGE NOTES

When we don't know who we are, or if we have wrong ideas about who we are...it will impact every <u>aspect</u> of our lives...

God wants us to understand why the <u>spiritual</u> bloodlines we inherit when we say Yes to Jesus as Lord are key factors in helping us form our **REAL ID**.

1. Why is <u>Blood</u> so Significant

Like water, blood is a fluid that is essential for life.

In the Scripture, blood is a powerful symbol for <u>humanity</u> itself (note <u>Leviticus</u> <u>17:14a</u>).

Note Genesis 3:21

Even before the Old Testament Law was given through Moses, it was clear that people understood that because of how crucial blood is to life, blood represented a <u>supreme</u> offering to God.

- Noah (Genesis 8:20)
- Abraham (Genesis 15, 22)
- <u>Isaac</u> (<u>Genesis 26</u>)
- Jacob (Genesis 31)
- Before 10 Commandments and Law, God instituted the <u>Passover</u> (note Exodus 12).

In the Old Testament Law, there were <u>multiple</u> types of sacrifices.

Major one was <u>Day</u> of Atonement (i.e., Yom Kippur; note <u>Leviticus 23</u>).

Also when the Old Covenant was confirmed (Exodus 24).

But none of these sacrifices, either alone or combined, could <u>sufficiently</u> pay the penalty for sin (note <u>Hebrews 10:1b-4</u>).

2. The Blood of Jesus Christ

God's ultimate plan was to provide the perfect, flawless sacrifice offered the right way that would <u>forever</u> pay the price for all past, present, and future sins.

Note Genesis 3:15

...Jesus became the <u>eternal</u> High Priest, entering heaven (i.e., the Holy of Holies), and once for all, not by the blood of animals being sacrificed, but by His own <u>precious</u> blood He shed on Good Friday (note <u>Hebrews 9:11-14</u>, <u>24-26</u>; <u>10:11-12</u>).

Note 1 John 2:2

So in the New Testament, it's Jesus' blood that becomes the <u>foundation</u> of God's new eternal covenant of love and grace.

When we say Yes to Jesus as Lord, we inherit an <u>incredible</u> bloodline...His blood:

- A. Redeems us (note Ephesians 1:7)
- B. Reconciles us to God (Romans 3:25)
- C. Paid our ransom (1 Peter 1:18-19; Revelation 5:9)
- D. <u>Washes</u> our sin away (<u>1 John 1:7</u>)
- E. Provides our complete forgiveness (Hebrews 9:22)
