

DISCUSSION GUIDE

ICEBREAKER WHAT IS THE BEST “NO” YOU’VE EVER RECEIVED FROM SOMEONE ELSE?

1. **READ THROUGH PSALM 57** INCLUDING THE INTRODUCTION. PASTOR TOM EXPLAINED THAT THE PSALMIST, DAVID, WROTE THIS WHILE FLEEING FOR HIS LIFE. CONSIDERING HIS CIRCUMSTANCES, WHICH PHRASES STAND OUT MOST TO YOU, AND HOW DO YOU THINK YOU’D HAVE RESPONDED?
2. PASTOR TOM STATED THAT “WHEN YOU KNOW THAT GOD HAS A PURPOSE FOR YOU, THEN EVERYTHING YOU EXPERIENCE IN LIFE...WILL HAVE A TRANSFORMED MEANING.” HOW MIGHT DAVID’S UNDERSTANDING OF GOD’S PURPOSE FOR HIS LIFE IMPACTED HIS PERSPECTIVE? DO YOU FIND IT EASIER TO GO THROUGH HARD THINGS WHEN YOU KNOW THERE IS A PURPOSE IN IT? WHAT ABOUT WHEN YOU DON’T SEE ANY PURPOSE?
3. PASTOR TOM REMINDED US THAT “GOD HAS A PURPOSE FOR OUR LIVES...BUT IT’S NOT ABOUT YOU ...EVERYTHING GOD DOES IS FOR HIS GLORY.” DO THESE STATEMENTS EXCITE, CALM OR CONFUSE YOU? WHY OR HOW?
4. **READ 1 CORINTHIANS 10:31**, PASTOR TOM IMploRED US WHEN HE SAID, “ONLY WHEN GOD IS AT THE CENTER OF OUR ORBIT OF OUR LIVES CAN WE EXPERIENCE THE WARMTH OF HIS LOVE AND THE LIGHT OF HIS TRUTH.” HOW CAN YOU MOVE AWAY FROM YOUR NATURAL TENDENCY OF SELF-CENTEREDNESS AND INSTEAD LIVE SO THAT WHATEVER YOU DO INTENTIONALLY BRINGS GLORY TO GOD?
5. PASTOR TOM SHOWED US THAT “GOD’S PURPOSE FOR MY LIFE IS TOTALLY IMMERSed IN HIS LOVE.” **READ PHILIPPIANS 2:6-11** AND **ISAIAH 53:5-6**. BASED ON THESE PASSAGES, HOW DID JESUS SHOW YOU GENUINE LOVE AND HOW SHOULD YOU RESPOND WITH YOUR LIFE?
6. IN HIS CONCLUSION, PASTOR TOM WARNED US NOT TO “MAKE THE MISTAKE SO MANY PEOPLE MAKE - JUST MAKE GOD A PART OF YOUR LIFE.” WHAT REAL NEXT STEPS **WILL** YOU TAKE THIS WEEK TO MOVE OUT OF THE CENTER AND ALLOW GOD TO BE THE CENTER OF YOUR UNIVERSE?


