Discussion Guide

- 1. Pastor Tom explains how wealth can hinder God's leadership in our lives. How have you seen this happen in your own life or those around you?
- 2. Read 2 Thessalonians 3:10 and Matthew 25:16. God tells us we must work and invest wisely to build wealth His way. How could these statements help change our attitude toward work? How does God's word show us ways we can invest wisely?
- 3. Read 1 Timothy 6:5-8 (NLT). How does the Bible challenge us here? What does contentment look like in your life? Where do you struggle with this?
- 4. Pastor Tom explained how money is supposed to be a tool to help us serve him and advance His kingdom. In what ways does this play out in your life? In the world?
- 5. Culturally "normal" in 2018 seems to promote living outside your means, accruing possessions, and acquiring debt. The Bible tells us to be "weird" and not store up earthly treasures. How do you respond to this? Do you find this difficult or easy? Why?
- 6. Read proverbs 13:7, 11. Over 30% of millionaires make less than \$90,000/ year. Does this surprise you? In what ways could you begin to be deliberate in your spending? What are some roadblocks you might face? What could be the reward? How can your group support you taking steps toward living this way?

So how can we make sure we're on the right side of "the coin" when it comes to God's purpose for money?

1. Why Wealth Can Hinder God's Leadership in Our Life and in the World

...money itself is not good or evil. It's <u>neutral</u>. It's how it's used and our motives and <u>place</u> we give it... Note 1 Timothy 6:3-5

...understand that from a global perspective, we are all wealthy.

2. Building Wealth God's Way (note Deuteronomy 8:18)

God tells us there are 2 ways to build wealth:

- Work (note 2 Thessalonians 3:10)
- Investments (note Matthew 25:16)
 - A. Act <u>poor</u> (note Proverbs 13:7) over 30% of all millionaires in USA make less than \$90,000.00 a year (and the average income of this group = \$76,000.00). They...<u>spend less</u> than they make.
 - B. Be deliberate (note Proverbs 13:11) most get rich schemes only make money for the person <u>promoting</u> them. Great formula for wealth = Money + <u>Time</u> + Consistency.
 - C. Don't put all your eggs in one basket (note Ecclesiastes 11:2)
 - D. <u>Grow</u> in what you know (note Proverbs 24:3-4) if it sounds too good to be true, if you can't <u>explain</u> it, and if you're not sure what it really is, don't put your money there.
