Ice Breaker What were your favorite Christmas traditions growing up, and why do you think they meant so much to you?



- 1. People have all kinds of responses when the words "giving" and "church" are used on a Sunday, let alone in a message. What is your first response to the idea that giving is not just important to the church, but to you as well?
- 2. Read Genesis 1:26-27. Pastor Tom talked about the Transitive Property of Equality and how, since we are made in God's image that our souls are hard wired to be giving. How does this confirm or challenge your thinking about the concept of giving?
- 3. Read 2 Corinthians 9:6-11. Being a cheerful giver brings joy to everyone, but especially our heavenly Father. What are some ways you have found joy as you've given, or how have you found it difficult to be a cheerful giver?
- 4. Read James 1:17-18, Philippians 4:14-18. How does having the facts around what you "own" make it easier to be a giver? Can you see how this puts you in a "bless-able" position? Discuss with your group how these things can be personally lived out, and what that would look like.
- 5. Pastor Tom shared how giving allows us to see what truly matters, and how giving is really us responding to God's invitation to partner with Him to save the world! How has God challenged your thinking about partnering with Him through your giving?

1. You Fulfill Your Purpose

Transitive Property of Equality (If A=B and B=C, then $\underline{A}=\underline{C}$) Note Genesis 1:26-27

Despite the fact that every person has spiritually defective DNA, we all still retain deep inside us God's image that causes us to <u>resemble</u> Him in some ways.

A=You were created in God's image.

B=God's nature is overflowing generosity (note 1 John 4:8 and John 3:16).

C=There's something deep inside you that's <u>wired</u> for giving/generosity.

Giving is hard-wired in our souls.

2. You Give God Joy

Note 1 John 3:1a

Note 2 Corinthians 9:7b

God loves it when we open our hand instead of clenching our fist; when we give willingly instead of saying, "That's mine".

3. You Put Yourself in a "Bless-Able" Place

We need to see the clear connection between our generosity and God providing for our <u>needs</u> (note Philippians 4:14-19).

Note Romans 8:32

If the best things in life can't be bought with money, perhaps God's most important blessings are not money and stuff.

4. You See More Clearly What Matters

We often have "b<u>uyer's regret</u>", but rarely regret something we give (note Matthew 6:21). <u>Money</u> isn't just a financial issue. It's primarily a <u>spiritual</u> issue.

Where we send our money identifies what we <u>value</u>. When you and I give, it shifts our perspective to <u>eternity</u>.

5. You Partner With God

God doesn't need your permission to <u>access</u> your resources. If He knows how many hairs are on your head, He knows your online banking <u>password!</u> While God doesn't need us, He <u>invites</u> us to participate.

When you give...you join with God in His mission. And when you give, you're a part of what God is doing everywhere. Do Your Dollars Make Sense?:
