

## **DISCUSSION GUIDE**

- **1.** Pastor Tom shared that we are called to God and shared numerous accounts of people Jesus called in the New Testament. How does it feel as you think about being in the same company as the disciples and others that we've heard about? (Matthew 4:18-22, 16:24-25, John 21:18-19)
- **2.** We are called not only to God, but also to become His church, which is comprised of Jesus-followers, not of buildings, church attenders or rituals. When we respond to God's calling to follow Jesus, we become a part of that church. (1 Corinthians 1:2, 9) What kind of realization is this for you?
- **3.** We are also called to experience His life which include His purposes, peace, freedom, eternal life, to do good and suffering. (Full statements and passages in Message Notes.) How do these showcase the importance of God's call on our lives? (Colossians 3:23-24)
- **4.** The last thing we are called to do is invest our life for Him. Pastor Tom said "God calls us to follow Him and serve Him in every part and place of life." What are some ways you're investing your life for Him?
- **5.** What was the biggest challenge from this week's message, and what steps will you take to create new habits that will enable you to meet it?

#### 1. To <u>Himself</u>

Note Genesis 1

Greek word =  $\underline{kletos}$  = a calling an invitation...

As God called Israel to be His people in the Old Testament, Jesus called people to follow Him:

- Apostles (note <u>Matthew 4:19</u>; <u>Luke 5:27</u>; <u>John 1:43</u>)
- Rich young ruler (note Mark 10:21)
- <u>Crowds</u> listening to Him (note <u>Matthew 16:24</u>)
- <u>Peter's</u> restoration after his failure and Jesus' resurrection (note <u>John</u> 21:19).

Church = ekklesia (kleis = a calling).

So the Church are called-out ones.

This calling is purely an act of God (note John 6:44; Acts 9:1-6).

#### Note Romans 1:6-7a; 1 Corinthians 1:2, 9; 2 Thessalonians 2:14

We have to respond to this <u>invitation</u> to become part of God's special people/family of *called-out ones*.

God calls us:

#### 2. To Experience His Life

- Called to God's purposes through <u>good</u> and painful experiences of life (note Romans 8:28).
- Called to <u>peace</u> (note <u>Colossians 3:15</u>).
- Called to freedom (note Galatians 5:8).
- Called to eternal life (note 1 Timothy 6:12).
- Called to do good (note 1 Peter 3:9).
- Called to suffering (note <u>1 Peter 4:16</u>).
