Your story matters, but so does your Story.

- Without it, we end up with both personal and worldwide plot holes.
- When we don't know who we are, or if we have wrong ideas about who we are... it will impact every aspect of our lives.

Checkpoint:

If my "truth" contradicts God's Truth, something has to change.

Always worth a review...

In the beginning <u>God</u> created the heavens and the earth. (<u>Genesis 1:1</u>)

So <u>God</u> created human beings in His own image. In the image of God He created them; male and female He created them. (<u>Genesis 1:27</u>)

The Lord <u>God</u> took the man and put him in the Garden of Eden to work it and take care of it. And the Lord <u>God</u> commanded the man, "You are free to eat from any tree in the garden; but you must not eat from the tree of the knowledge of good and evil, for when you eat from it you will certainly die." (<u>Genesis 2:15-17</u>)

Our Story doesn't begin with a gap.

Our creative Creator simultaneously created <u>beauty</u> and <u>order</u>.

But, there is a hole that we're quite familiar with.

- The choice the first humans were given is our same choice: (pick one)
 - ☐ I'll offer myself to God, trust in His knowledge of good/evil and step into His Story
 - ☐ I'll seize power, try to define good/evil myself and create a story

Some common reasons we get stuck?

- We stop at the <u>headline</u> versus <u>discovering</u> the whole story.
- We're surrounded by well-meaning-yet-still-destructive <u>affirmation</u> and <u>collaboration</u>—not fully owning how God is into <u>transformation</u>.

But... T.H.E.R.E. I.S. H.O.P.E.

- Trinity, Heritage, Enemy, Revolution, Ego
- Identity, Shhh...
- Hero, Opportunity, Purpose, Eternity

Authority stems from the <u>Author</u> (1 Peter 1:3-16)

- Revelation (v.3a): Any true authority depends on a True <u>Author</u>.
 - o Action step: <u>Praise</u>
- Foundation (v.3b): When we stumble upon a space, we fill it with a <u>story</u>.
 - o Action step: Repent
- Implication (v.4-5): Don't ignore familiar <u>riches</u>—claim your <u>inheritance</u>.
 - o Action step: <u>Ask</u>
- Integration (v.6-12): Fight for your LIFE in everyday <u>surrender</u> to God.
 - o Action step: Yield
- Application (v.13-16): Your deeds won't <u>save</u> you, but they might help someone else get <u>saved</u>.
 - o Action step:
