DISCUSSION GUIDE

Icebreaker: As we transition to warm summer days, don our flip flops and shorts we begin to see the inevitable skinned knees and elbows occurring around us. What's your best scar/scraped knee/elbow story?

- **1.** Read <u>John 8:30-32</u>; <u>1:1, 14</u>. Why should we remain faithful to the teachings of Jesus?
- **2.** Read through Pastor Tom's notes on how nothing remotely compares to the Scriptures. What is most impactful to you as you consider these different aspects of the Bible?
- **3.** Pastor Tom told us "...we need truth to dominate our lives." How have you seen truth be "elusive, obscured, twisted, and ignored" in your own life or the lives of others? What was the result?
- 4. "What we accept as our life authority matters profoundly, because there are so many loud voices in this world competing for our devotion." How should Jesus' words as the authority over your life impact your choices this week?
- **5.** Pastor Tom's challenge to us was bold: "...if you're here today and say you believe the Bible and even call it God's Word, but you're not reading it and letting God use it to change your life, you're missing the whole point..." What next steps can you take this week to prioritize reading God's Word? Ask your group to help you stay accountable.
