## **DISCUSSION GUIDE**

Icebreaker: My favorite summer family tradition is...

- **1.** How does Jesus' mission to reach lost people (<u>Luke 19:10</u>, <u>John 3:16</u>) get you excited about what God has been doing at Riverside Church?
- 2. In John 15, Jesus talks about bearing fruit...of reaching lost people. (John 15:8, 16) How has this looked in your life? How would you like it to look?
- **3.** Let's take another look at what scripture has to say about Jesus' mission on earth.
  - a. Matthew 1:21 (Even before Jesus' birth)
  - b. <u>John 3:17</u>; <u>12:27</u> (Jesus' own teaching)
  - c. <u>1 Timothy 1:15</u>, <u>1 John 2:2</u> (The New Testament agrees)
  - d. Mark 16:15, Acts 1:8, Romans 10:13-15 (We have a role to play)
  - e. How do you fit in?
- **4.** Being outward focused isn't our default setting, but it is still the heart of God for the world. How are we able to live this out? (Acts 1:8) Is today your day to surrender completely to the Holy Spirit and allow Him to empower you to live the life you were designed for?
- **5.** Pastor Tom said "Lost people matter to God. He wants them found. And they need to matter to us." Who has God put in your life that still needs to be found? If you're honest, are you acting like they matter to you?

#### MESSAGE NOTES

The average life span of a church in MN is about <u>70</u> years old.

Note <u>Luke 19:10</u> and <u>John 3:16</u>

Since <u>80</u>% of evangelical churches (and higher % of mainline churches) are either <u>plateaued</u> or declining, God has without a doubt helped Riverside these past nearly 18 years be on a road less traveled.

...Jesus has told us that <u>every</u> human being (including you and me) are all on a road trip, so to speak; but the road we choose to travel on will make all the <u>difference</u> in this life and eternity (note <u>Matthew 7:13-14</u>).

Note <u>John 15:8, 16</u>

### 1. What is the Fruit Jesus Talks About in John 15?

Fruit/Fruitful is used <u>66</u> times in the New Testament...<u>41</u> of 66 times in New Testament used <u>figuratively</u>...

- A. Fruit of Salvation (note Matthew 13:23).
- B. Fruit of <u>Evangelism</u> (note <u>John 4:35-36</u>) in John 15:8, Jesus is talking to His disciples who had already <u>said Yes</u> to Jesus as Lord. Note <u>John 15:1</u>; <u>Matthew 4:19</u>; <u>John 15:16</u>; <u>Matthew 28:19a</u>. The road less traveled Jesus tells us to travel on has reaching <u>lost</u> people as a primary mile marker (note <u>Proverbs 11:30</u>).

## 2. Why is Something So Clear...

...so hard to find among so many churches and so many Jesus followers?

- Jesus' mission was clearly spelled out even before His <u>birth</u> (note <u>Matthew</u>
   1:21).
- Jesus was <u>clear</u> about His mission (note <u>John 3:17</u>; <u>12:27</u>).
- The <u>rest</u> of the New Testament is clear about Jesus' mission (note <u>1</u> <u>Timothy 1:15</u>; <u>1 John 2:2</u>).
- And Jesus was clear that His followers were to have as their #1 priority the completion of His mission (note Mark 16:15; Acts 1:8; Matthew 24:14).

The problem isn't lack of <u>clarity</u> or information.

The problem is...that the <u>natural</u> inclination of any organization is to become inward-focused.

This was true for Jesus' own disciples (note <u>Luke 9:46</u>; <u>Acts 1:6</u>).

Being outward-focused isn't our <u>default</u> setting...but being outward-focused is God's <u>default</u> setting, and He can establish this perspective and passion in our hearts by His Spirit (note the changes from <u>Acts 1:6</u> to <u>Acts 2:41</u>).

#### Am I on the road less traveled?:

- When God started this church 90 years ago, He made sure to <u>engrave</u> this DNA of outward-focus into Riverside's foundation.
- ...on our 90th birthday, Riverside is reaching more lost people than ever before...and there are more lost people to reach than ever before...
- Lost people matter to God; He wants them found. And they need to matter to us.
