Key passage: John 17:11-21

- Our <u>Savior</u> is a starting point.

 - Culture demands narration
 - Sin demands domination
 - o We demand <u>validation</u>
- The <u>Truth</u> is our launching point.
 - The Bible isn't a book of ideas of how to live a moral life—it is <u>ALIVE</u> and reveals Life.
