

# **DISCUSSION GUIDE**

*Icebreaker:* If you could live anywhere in the world for a year, where would it be?

- 1. Pastor Tom shared that when everyone and everything around you is standing for anything and everything else but God and His truth, you need hope. In what areas of your life do you need hope today?
- 2. Pastor Tom explained that Elijah and the widow both followed God's Word even when it was hard to understand. Have you ever had to do the same and what was that experience like?
- **3**. Read <u>1 Kings 17:12</u>, <u>15-16</u>. Pastor Tom asked, "Will we actually believe what God has said?" What areas of your life do you find it challenging to believe what God has said?
- **4.** Read <u>1 Kings 17:19-24</u>. The widow and Elijah both cried out to God in their grief, pain and confusion and God did not respond with rebuke or correction. Pastor Tom explained that God's shoulders are wide enough and strong enough to handle our questions, struggles and pain. Do you struggle to honestly cry out to God when life doesn't make sense? Explain.
- 5. In what ways can you move from knowing God's truth to actively embracing God's truth?

### "WHEN YOU NEED HOPE"

#### **MESSAGE NOTES**

Last Sunday we began this new series where our focus is on learning what it means to stand for God and His truth and embrace His <u>mission</u> when everyone and everything around us is standing for anything and everything else but God and His truth.

#### Note 1 Kings 17:6, 7

When everyone and everything around you is standing for anything and everything else but God and His truth, you need <u>hope</u>.

# **1.** Follow God's Word Even When It's Hard to <u>Understand</u> (note 1 Kings 17:8-9)

Of any place God could have sent Elijah, He sends him on a <u>100</u> mile journey (<u>on foot</u>) to a foreign nation where God and His truth were unknown or rejected, where false religions dominated the culture, and where Elijah would be a "fish out of water".

And who is Elijah to be helped by? A widow!

Note Deuteronomy 15:11

Note <u>1 Kings17:12</u>

And God's Word to this widow also seemed <u>ludicrous</u> (note <u>1 Kings 17:13-14</u>). Both Elijah (note <u>1 Kings 7:10a</u>) and this widow (note <u>1 Kings 17:15a</u>) <u>decide to follow</u> God's Word even when it was hard to understand...

# 2. <u>Trust</u> God to do What Only He Can Do

Will we actually <u>believe</u> what God has said (not just intellectual <u>assent;</u> note <u>James 2:19</u>)?

Note <u>1 Kings 17:12</u>, <u>15-16</u>

## **3.** Honestly Cry Out to God When Life Doesn't Make Sense

Note <u>1 Kings 17:17-18</u>

Note <u>John 9:1-3</u>

...this widow honestly cried out in her grief, pain, and confusion...

#### Note 1 Kings 17:19-20

Notice in both the case of the widow and Elijah, God doesn't <u>rebuke</u>, correct, or strike them down for honestly crying out to Him.

His shoulders are wide and strong enough to bear the weight of our <u>questions</u>, struggles, and pain.

Some tried to claim Elijah did the first CPR here (note 1 Kings 17:21a).

Purely <u>symbolic</u> (up until 1 Kings 17, no one had ever been raised from the dead; Elijah had no <u>template</u> to work with).

But Elijah knew who had the <u>power</u> of life and death (note <u>1 Kings 17:21b</u>).

#### **SO WHO'S GOT THIS IN YOUR LIFE?:**

- At the beginning of 1 Kings 17, God demonstrated He alone had power over nature.
- At the end of 1 Kings 17, He shows He alone is the Giver of life... (note <u>1 Kings</u> 17:22-23).
- And this widow moves from acknowledging that Elijah <u>serves</u> the Lord (note 1 Kings 17:12a)...
- ...to saying 'YES!' to this God and <u>embracing</u> for herself this truth (note <u>1 Kinas 17:24</u>).
