- 4. According to Genesis 2:18, Acts 2:44, Proverbs 27:17,

  1 Peter 4:9, Galatians 6:2 and Romans 12:15, "we're wired to have meaningful relationships". Describe a time you experienced or witnessed a close relationship that developed as people chose to share their experiences, homes, challenges, and difficulties.
- 5. Take time to read Act 2:42a, Romans 12:10a, 1 John 3:10, 14, 16, 18-20 and John 13:34-35 to see how God's family is to be our "next-of-kin." What would you need to change this week to love as God laid out in these passages?

## 2. God's Family are to be Next-of-Kin

Kinship = your <u>closest</u> relationships. Note <u>Act 2:42a</u> and <u>Romans 12:10a</u> Note John 3:16 and 1 John 3:16

Where there's genuine love, people will be attracted to Jesus and to church, because people aren't looking for more <u>meetings</u>/events to attend, or just another religious structure...they're looking for family, <u>next-of-kin</u> levels of relationships (note <u>John 13:34-35</u>).

And the way we <u>know</u> we're in God's family is: (note <u>1 John 3:10, 14</u>; <u>4:20</u>) God wants His family to be a <u>laboratory</u> in learning to love.

#### **MYTH**UNDERSTANDING:

- God's family is where we learn to love real (not <u>ideal</u>) people (there are no ideal people).
- Are you even a part of God's family? (note Galatians 3:26)
