2. <u>Recall</u> Our Need of Forgiveness

3. Realize Unforgiveness has the <u>Boomerang</u> Effect

Resentment and unforgiveness always <u>hurts</u> you more than the person you resent.

Unforgiveness allows others to exert $\underline{\mathsf{power}}$ over us.

The longer we hold onto the pain and hurt, the <u>bigger</u> the price we pay (note <u>Ephesians 4:26-27, 31-32</u>).

4. <u>Release</u> the Other Person

Release = <u>set free</u>

Note <u>Matthew 18:23-35</u>

Unforgiveness <u>blocks</u> God's blessing and forgiveness coming into our own lives.

- **A.** Forgive <u>ASAP</u>.
- **B.** Forgive <u>completely</u>.
- **C.** Forgive <u>freely</u> the catch is there is <u>no catch</u>!
- D. Forgive repeatedly (note Romans 12:18).

WHAT'S DRIVING ME?:

- If we decide to not forgive, we <u>circumvent</u> God's best plan for our life, and we actually put ourselves in God's place (note <u>Romans 12:19</u>).
- Unforgiveness <u>forges</u> strong and harsh chains in our lives.
- When we choose to forgive we <u>invite</u> God to come in and heal the hurt.
- Unforgiveness is like drinking <u>poison</u> and waiting for the other person to get sick.
- <u>Forgiveness</u> has nothing to do with the person who has hurt us.
- It has everything to do with us (note <u>Colossians 3:13</u>).
