- 1. What steps towards exercising forgiveness have you taken this week?
- 2. Pastor Tom shared how fear is something we all deal with and shared several quotes to illustrate that. But then he tells us what Jesus said more than any other statement: "Don't be afraid." What are some of the fears Jesus has helped you overcome in the past?
- Jesus overcomes huge fears and circumstances in the lives of people in <u>Matthew 8:3-6</u>, <u>13b-16</u>, <u>22-33</u>. After reading these passages, what are you experiencing that seems too much, even for Jesus?
- 4. Pastor Tom shared why fear so often wedges its way into our lives. Which of these are your reality right now, and how can we as a group help each other replace fear with faith? (Read through point 3 and its passages as you process this question.)
- 5. Read <u>1 John 4:16, 18a</u> and ask the Holy Spirit to drive out whatever you are fearing and replace that with the peace of His presence.

MESSAGE NOTES

The reality is that every <u>single</u> person...is driven by something. <u>Drive</u> = to guide, control, direct.

Note Matthew 8:24-26a

Whether we admit it/show it or not, fear is the consistent, <u>unwanted</u> companion of human beings.

What makes fear such a <u>driving</u> and all-encompassing force in our lives?

1. Fear Has Long and Numerous <u>Tentacles</u>

Fear doesn't <u>discriminate</u>; it knows no boundaries of time or place. (Hoselton)

The list of fears is <u>long</u> and impacts everyone in some way. Fear is so commonplace that it <u>wedges</u> its way into all parts of life.

Fear...<u>hollows</u> out [our] insides, until [our] resistance and strength are spent and [we] suddenly break down. Fear secretly gnaws and eats away at all the ties that bind a person to God and to others, and when in a time of need that person reaches for those ties and <u>clings</u> to them, they break and the individual sinks back into himself or herself, helpless and despairing. (Bonhoeffer)

Fear pollutes our thinking, distorts our judgment, <u>cripples</u> our resistance to evil, dislodges our love, and casts a gloom over our hearts. (Hoselton) In the 4 Gospels, the statement Jesus makes more than any other (<u>21</u> times) = Don't be afraid.

2. Why Jesus <u>Trounces</u> Fear

Note Matthew 8:3-6 Note Matthew 8:13b-16 Note Matthew 8:22-33 No matter what form fear took, or how <u>impressive</u> the fears appeared to be, fear was no match for Jesus' presence, power, Word, and life.

Despite this reality, in this same chapter, Jesus' closest friends/followers would be overcome by fear.

3. So Why Does Fear Often Wedge Its Way Into Our Lives?

- A. It's easier to trust Jesus for other people's <u>challenges</u> than our own fear seems less fearful when someone else has to face it <u>directly</u>.
- B. Fear rarely gives us time to prepare (note Matthew 8:23-24a).
- C. Fear is <u>magnified</u> when we realize we're not in control (note <u>Matthew</u> 8:24).
- D. Fear makes us think God doesn't care/is <u>disengaged</u> (note <u>Matthew</u> 8:24b).
- E. We <u>replace</u> trust/faith with fear (note <u>Matthew 8:26a</u>) we don't need <u>faith</u> when life is easy, but when life is hard.

WHAT'S DRIVING ME?

- So has fear wedged its way into your life and is driving you down one scary road after another?
- Jesus is <u>closer</u> than you think.
