- Icebreaker -Share a hobby, interest or dabbling you have that no one else in the room (besides family) knows about.

- On pages 140-141, the author says, "forgiveness means sacrifice" and that for forgiveness to happen the one who has been hurt has to "pay again". How does this make you feel and why?
- 2. Pastor Tom showed us in the life of Joseph that the thing that needs to be sacrificed (surrendered to God) is our hurt, or we will be weighed down with anger, bitterness, and unresolved emotional issues. Share how you have experienced this to be true in your own life, and how you have tried to resolve it.
- Joseph proved that forgiving others sets us free to not just survive, but to thrive. Think of a time when you were hurt by someone else. How would (did) choosing to forgive set you free emotionally, spiritually, or relationally?
- 4. Read <u>Genesis 45:5-8</u> & <u>Romans 8:28-29</u>. Pastor Tom indicated that part of what made Joseph able to forgive more readily was his perspective of God's sovereign hand over the entirety of his life – even the hurts and injustices he experienced. How can this perspective help you forgive the hurts and injustices in your life?
- 5. Pastor Tom said that forgiveness happens in steps: the choice to "Forgive", the process of "Forgiving", and the final resolution of "Forgiven". Think of a hurt that needs to be forgiven for you to move into freedom. Where are you in the process of forgiveness and what is your next step? How can we encourage your follow through?

The journey to freedom and experiencing a more unoffendable life goes through the door of forgiveness.

Forgiveness means:

1. I <u>Surrender</u> My Hurts to a Sovereign God

- A. Born in a <u>dysfunctional</u> family (note <u>Genesis 37</u>).
- B. <u>Rejected</u> by his brothers (note <u>Genesis 37</u>).
- C. <u>Abandoned</u> to a foreign country (note <u>Genesis 37</u>).
- D. Sold into slavery (note Genesis 39).
- E. <u>Falsely</u> accused of rape (note <u>Genesis 39</u>).
- F. Sent to prison unjustly (note <u>Genesis 39</u>).
- G. <u>Forgotten</u> by a "friend" (note <u>Genesis 40:14-15, 23</u>; <u>41:1</u>).
